

Dalton Piercy Parish Council
Minutes of special meeting held at 7.00 pm on Monday 29th April 2019
at Dalton Piercy Village Hall

Present: Cllrs D. Rezai (Chair), A. Timothy, L Noble and Cllr J Bearby (JB joined the meeting at 7.30pm)

Meeting began at 7.05pm.

1. **Apologies for Absence:** M. Patrick, L, Moses, A. Burroughs. **Accepted and Approved.**

2. **2019 Grantscape funding list:**

Cllr L Noble presented a list of suggested projects which DPPC could put forward for funding bids to Grantscape and the Red Gap Community Fund.

The Clerk read the list of works members of the public had put forward at the 2018 annual Parish meeting.

A discussion took place.

It was **Agreed** the following items should be costed and investigated further with a view to deciding which projects should be put forward for funding at the next full PC meeting (May 11th 2019)

- 'The Batts' environmental and naturalisation works. A.T. to **Action**
- Village environment (landscape) improvements to include; Village green track works – revealing 'buried' blue cobble curb stones and the possibility of installing more. Further pond landscaping including planting. Tree works and reed removal. L.N. to **Action**
- Village security/crime deterrents. CCTV and or security lighting (possibly solar powered) for the areas close to The Batts entrance and Village Picnic area/proposed play area site. Solar Lighting for the path to the Village Hall. D.R. to **Action**
- Footpath continuation. D.R. to **Action**
- Installation of a decorative Village pump – on the green close to College Farm and safety improvements including a secure cover for the well close to Rose Cottage. J.B. to **Action**

It was **Agreed** that on this occasion the following items would not be put forward;

- Generator/Battery and spare wooden flower tubs – both not required at this time.
- Litter picking kits – already being supplied by HBC.
- Allotment Play equipment – Withdrawn due to no kids' club.
- Physical speed barriers e.g. speed bumps – investigate with HBC.
- Replacement lampposts – investigate with HBC/could need a large amount of funding.

Applications must be submitted to Grantscape by 29th May 2019. Project consideration will be on 9th July 2019.
